

Introduction

The Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training is an autonomous statutory authority created under 'The Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training 1992 Act' for regulating

and controlling academic standards in Institutes of Technical Education and for making admissions & conducting examinations in Polytechnics and Industrial Training Institutes.

Activities of the Board

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The Board is carrying out the following major activities:-

- 1 Admissions:** - The Board makes admissions to 33 Engineering Diploma Courses in 165 Institutions affiliated to the Board in the State of Punjab and Chandigarh (U.T.). The Board admits about 65,000 students to various diploma courses in these Institutes.
- 2. Registration of students:** - The students admitted to the various affiliated Polytechnic Institutions of Board are issued

photo-registration cards as bonafide student of the Board.

- 3. Conduct of examination:** - The Board conducts two semester examinations every year i.e. May and December for diploma courses. This also includes the supplementary examinations.
- 4. Certification of the pass out students:** - The successful students who complete their diploma course are issued computerised/ calligraphically written final diploma certificates.
