

INTRODUCTION

The Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training is an autonomous statutory authority created under 'The Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training Act 1992' for regulating and controlling academic standards in Institutes of Technical Education and for making admissions & conducting examinations in Polytechnics and Industrial Training Institutes.

ACTIVITIES OF THE BOARD

1. Admissions:

The Board makes admissions to Diploma level courses in the Institutions affiliated with the Board in the State of Punjab and Chandigarh (U.T.) The Board admits about 65,000 students to various diploma courses in these Institutes.

2. Registration of students:

The students admitted to the various affiliated Polytechnic Institutions of Board are issued photo-registration cards as bonafide students of the Board.

3. Conduct of examination:

The Board conducts semester examination every year in the month of May and December. This also includes the supplementary examinations.

4. Certification of the pass out students:

The successful students who complete their diploma course are issued computerized / calligraphically written diploma certificates.
