**NOTIFICATION**

No.DTE-CBONOTI/1/2020-CONDUCT/ 579      Dated Chandigarh, the 01-07-2020

The Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the Punjab State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Chandigarh ( hereinafter the Board) as the authority competent to make admission to Four Year Part Time Diploma Courses for the academic session 2020-21. The Board shall recommend and authorize admission to the Part Time Diploma Course being run in the various Polytechnics/ Institutions located in the State of Punjab affiliated with the Board and stand approved by the All India Council for Technical Education for the session 2019-20. Any addition of courses or any increase or decrease in the seats for the year 2020-21, the Board is authorized for affiliation of the Polytechnics/Institutes at its own level as per the procedure laid down on the basis of the approval of All India Council for Technical Education.

**A)      ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PART TIME DIPLOMA LEVEL COURSES**

- I              The admission to the Part Time Diploma level Engineering Courses shall be through online counseling. Student should be passed 10<sup>th</sup> standard/SSC examination and two years ITI after 10<sup>th</sup> standard.

or

Passed 10<sup>th</sup> standard /SSC examination and minimum of two year full time experience in registered firm/company/industry/educational and/Government/ autonomous organization in the relevant field in which admission is sought.
- II             Part time diploma course is only for working professionals.
- III.          Part time Diploma shall be conducted in evening time i.e. 5.30 PM to 9.30 PM (Six days a week) and its Duration shall be of 4 years.
- IV            For the Academic session 2020-21, 85% seats shall be reserved for the internal candidates from within the State of Punjab and 15% shall be open to all candidates from outside Punjab on All India basis.
- V             The Eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that candidate shall be a resident of Punjab State as per Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3PPII/9619 dated 6<sup>th</sup> June 1996 and letter No. 1/3/95-3PPII /80 dated 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1999 or shall have passed the matriculation examination from an institution/school affiliated to Punjab School Education Board/CBSE/ICSE/ National Open School situated in Punjab. The candidate would be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal/Head of Institution last attended in the prescribed Performa as given in the prospectus.
- VI.          Apart from the basic educational qualifications prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as mentioned in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 35/44/95-1T(2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003.
- VII.         The State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab shall formulate a scheme for making admissions.

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- VIII. The students shall pay the fees/ development fee and other charges both for the various seats, as per rates fixed by the Government of Punjab or the Board.
- IX. The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/PIO shall be the same as is in vogue for Hltl candidates.
- X. The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per Punjab Government in this regard (Memo No 8/21/11-1TE2/501423/1 dated 05.06.2015)
- XI. The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/ Persons of Indian Origin shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No 13/75/2001-1TE2/295 dated Chandigarh the 23<sup>rd</sup> January, 2003
- XII. The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt. Departments of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2008, no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 dated 20<sup>th</sup> June 2008 and No 13/129/03-1TE2/171 dt.17<sup>th</sup> January 2011 as amended from time to time
- XIII. There shall be no bifurcation of the seats into "free seats" and "paid seats" This is in compliance with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its judgment the case of T.M.A. Pai Foundation and other vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) (B SCC 481, AIR 2004 SC 355), and the instructions of Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development and the AICTE.
- XIV. Admission of candidates, who fulfill all eligibility conditions, shall be made on the basis of the relative merit subject to reservation of seats, the detailed instructions in respect of which are given in Section B.
- XV. Academic session for newly admitted students may commence as per the academic schedule of AICTE for AY 2020-21.
- XVI. State Government reserves its right to change any condition at any point of time due to COVID-19 situation.

**B) RESERVATION:**

- I. The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013 and Memo No. 8/41/2019-4TE2/63 dated 13<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2019. As regards the reservation of seats of Polytechnics under Union Territory, Chandigarh, the same shall be as per the policy intimated by the Chandigarh Administration to the Board.
- II. The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category whatsoever is especially drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been issued on or before the last date of counselling shall only be accepted. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the cut-off date, otherwise their certificates shall not be considered and their claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. No extension shall be granted in this regard, under any circumstances. This provision should be given wide publicity and also included conspicuously in the prospectus-cum-information brochure to be issued by the Board.



III

The Board shall make a provision in the Online Admission application form for the candidates to indicate the category, if any, under which they are seeking reservation. In case of no reservation is claimed in the application form, candidate shall be treated as general category. The Government of Punjab may also set up a Committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013. In the absence of this Committee, the Board shall effect this inter se gradation, in accordance with the criteria laid down in the aforesaid memo dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2013.

IV.

A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation under one reserved category only. However, the procedure for counselling/allotment of courses and/ or institutes shall be such that if a candidate is getting a course/ institution higher in his/her order of preference, as a general candidate, he/ she shall be so regarded, notwithstanding his/her claim as a reserved category candidate. The seat under the reserved category shall then be offered to the candidates in that very reserved category.

V.

The unfilled seat in any reserved category shall be merged in the General Category quota after all eligible candidates of the reserved categories have been called for counselling.

C)

#### **ONLINE- COUNSELLING**

I.

For the admission to Part Time Diploma web based online counseling shall be followed for the Academic year 2020-21 and therefore physical presence of candidates for the counseling will not be necessary.

II.

During the online counselling, candidate shall be given opportunity to exercise choice of institutes/trade in centralized counselling and thereafter the vacant seats, if any, shall be filled by the institute on the criteria of admissions under management quota. It is categorically laid down that vacant seats are not being transferred as management quota seats. Only criteria as laid down for admission under management quota should remain applicable to fill such vacant seats.

III.

The Board shall give a public notice in leading newspapers regarding the schedule of counselling.

IV.

While fixing the date of counselling for admissions, the Board shall keep in view the cut off date and schedule for approval by All India Council for Technical Education for the academic session 2020-2021.

v.

There shall be two rounds of centralized counselling by State Board of Technical Education, Punjab Chandigarh. The 2<sup>nd</sup> counselling should be over by 1st of August 2020 and the admission consequent to this, should be allowed till 5<sup>th</sup> August. Thereafter the 3<sup>rd</sup> direct online counselling at the College/Institute level shall be allowed for vacant seats from 6<sup>th</sup> August 2020 and The Punjab State Board of Technical Education Punjab, Chandigarh will issue necessary instructions to the institutions in this regard. The process of online registration of such seats should be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> August by all means.

D)

#### **ADMISSION SCHEDULED**

- I. As per revised AICTE Academic Calendar for Academic Year 2020-21, last date up to which students can be admitted against vacancies is 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2020 as allowed by the honorable supreme court in the civil appeal filed in case of Parashva Nath Charitable Trust V/S All India Council for Technical Education, in view of the Covid-19 situation.

**E) FEE WAIVER SCHEME**

- I. The Admissions under Fee Waiver Scheme of AICTE, shall be made by Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training through online counselling simultaneously with general counselling in supersession of the Govt. Notification No. 13/60/08-1TE2/1797 dated 23.05.2011, Notification No. 13/60/80/1TE2/2007 dated 31.05.2012, Memo No. 751-752/S-1/ECC/2015 dated 13.05.2015 and Memo No. 428-430/S-5/ECC/2019 dated 04.04.2019 as per , the terms and conditions laid down by All India Council for Technical Education from time to time.

**F) OVER-RIDING PROVISION:**

- I. Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the law of the land as laid down of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of T.M.A. Pai Foundation and other vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) (8 SCC 481: AIR 2004 SC 355). Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Government of Punjab, clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification.
- II. The institutions which do not make admission on the basis of the Joint Entrance Test and Central Admission procedure as notified by the Board, from time to time or violate any of the above terms and conditions, shall automatically stand disaffiliated from the Board without any further notice.
- III. The notifications, circulars and instructions of the Government of Punjab as referred to in A-V, A-VI, A-X, A-XI, A-XII, A-XIII, B-I, D-I, E-I and F-I in this notification shall be treated as part of this notification for all purposes and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of said notification/ circulars and instructions.
