The Governor of Punjab is pleased to appoint the Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Chandigarh (hereinafter the Board) as the authority competent to make admissions in the 2nd year of various Three Year Diploma level Engineering & Technology Courses under LEET Scheme for the session 2021-22. The Board shall recommend and authorize admissions to 2nd year of diploma level Engineering & Technology Courses under LEET Scheme being run in all the Polytechnics/Institutions located in the State of Punjab and Union Territory, Chandigarh, which are affiliated with the Board and approved by the All India Council for Technical Education for the session 2020-21.

A. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION FOR LATERAL ENTRY TO DIPLOMA ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY COURSES.

I Candidates who have passed

10+2 Examination with Physics/ Mathematics/ Chemistry/ Computer Science/ Electronics/ Information Technology/ Biology/ Informatics Practices/ Biotechnology/ Technical Vocational subject/ Agriculture/ Engineering Graphics/ Business Studies/ Entrepreneurship (Any of the three)

OR

10th+(2 years ITI) with appropriate trade

in that order shall be eligible for admission to second year Diploma course(s) of appropriate program, up to a maximum of 10% of sanctioned intake plus the unfilled vacancies of the First Year.

Vacant seats arising out of the students withdrawing the admission in the First Year shall also be considered for Lateral Entry.

I I Admission to LEET seats shall be made on the basis of relative merit in the qualifying examination mentioned above.

I I I It is further provided that seats remaining unfilled on the basis of eligibility criteria mentioned in Para A-I , shall be filled on the basis of inter-se-merit of:

(i) 10+2 Vocational examination in various branches from a board recognized or established by Central /State Government through a legislation.

(ii) Two years certificate course from Sant Longowal Institute of Engg. and Technology, Longowal and have Punjab Domicile.

(iii) Two years certificate course in Skill Technician (Machinist), Skill Technician (Machine Maintenance) & Quality Assurance Inspector from R&D Centre for Bicycle & Sewing Machine, Ludhiana.

IV For the Academic session 2021-22, 85% seats shall be reserved for the internal candidates from within the State of Punjab and 15% shall be open to the candidates from outside Punjab on All-India basis.

V The Eligibility criteria for 85% seats will be that the candidate shall be a resident of Punjab State as per Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (PP II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3PP/9619 dated 6th June 1996 and letter No. 1/3/95-3PP/80 dated 1st January, 1999 and should have passed the examination mentioned at Sr. No. I and III from an institution/school situated in Punjab. The candidate would be required to submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal/Head of Institution last attended in the prescribed Performa as given in the prospectus.

VI. Apart from the basic educational qualification prescribed above, the general eligibility criteria shall be as has been mentioned in Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 35/44/95-IT (2)/978 dated 21st March, 2003.

VII. The State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab shall formulate a scheme for making admissions.

VIII Admission of candidates, who fulfill all other conditions, shall be made on the basis of the relative merit in qualifying examination subject to reservation of seats, detailed instructions in respect of which are given in Section C.

IX. The students shall pay the fees, development fee and other charges, as per rates of fees/development fee and other charges as fixed by Government of Punjab/UT of Chandigarh or the Board.

X. The fee structure for Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian Origin shall be the same as is in vogue for NRI candidates.

XI. The guidelines for admission of Kashmiri migrants shall be as per Punjab Government in this regard, (Memo No. 8/21/11-ITE2/501423/1 dated 05.06.2015)

XII. The guidelines for admission of Foreign Nationals/ Persons of Indian Origin shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 13/75/2001-ITE2/296 dated Chandigarh the 23rd January, 2003.

XIII. The guidelines for admission of Sikh minority community students to Guru Nanak Dev Polytechnic College, Ludhiana and Baba Banda Singh Bahadur Polytechnic College, Fatehgarh Sahib shall be as per Punjab Government Notification No. 18/33/2001-GC (6) 4513 dated Chandigarh, the 3rd April, 2001.

XIV. The management quota shall be as per Punjab Govt. Department of technical Education and Industrial Training Memo no 13/129/2003-1TE2/1247 dated 25th April 2008, no. 13/129/2003-1TE2/1892 dated 20th June 2008 and No.13/129/03-1TE2/171 dt.17th January 2011 as amended from time to time.

XV. There shall be no bifurcation of the seats into "free seats" and "paid seats". This is in compliance with the judgment of the Honorable Supreme Court of India vide its judgment the case of T.M.A. Pai Foundation and other vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) (8 SCC 481: AIR 2004 SC 355), and the instructions of Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development and the AICTE.

XVI. Academic session for newly admitted students may commence as per the academic schedule of AICTE for AY 2021-22.

XVII. State Government reserves its right to change any condition at any point of time.

B. ONLINE- COUNSELLING

I. The admission for lateral entry to diploma in Engineering & Technology courses shall be conducted through web based online counselling for the Academic year 2021-22 and therefore physical presence of candidates for the counselling will not be necessary.

II. During the online counselling, candidate shall be given opportunity to exercise choice of institutes / trade in centralized counselling and thereafter the vacant seats, if any, shall be filled by the institute on the criteria of admissions under management quota. It is categorically laid down that vacant seats are not being transferred as management quota seats. Only criteria as laid down for admission under management quota should remain applicable to fill such vacant seats.

III. The Board shall give a public notice in leading newspapers regarding the schedule of counselling.

IV. While fixing the date of counseling for admissions, the Board shall keep in view the cutoff date and schedule for approval by All India Council

for Technical Education for the academic session 2021-22.

V. There shall be two rounds of centralized counselling by State Board of Technical Education, Punjab Chandigarh. The schedule and Deadline of counselling will be as per the academic calendar issued by AICTE in July 2021 for the academic session 2021-22 and strictly as per the orders of honorable Supreme Court.

C.

RESERVATION:

I. The reservation of seats shall be as per Punjab Government, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training Memo. No. 13/2/05-1TE2/1987 dated 2nd July, 2013 and Memo No. 8/41/2019-4TE2/53 dated 13th Sep, 2019. As regards the reservation of seats of Polytechnics under Union Territory, Chandigarh, the same shall be as per the policy intimated by the Chandigarh Administration to the Board.

II. The attention of the applicants desirous of claiming reservation under any category is drawn to the condition and stipulation that only the certificates that have been issued on or before the last date of counseling shall be accepted. The candidates are accordingly advised, in their own interest, to get the requisite certificates issued well before the cut-off date, otherwise their certificates shall not be considered and their claim for reservation shall be summarily rejected. No extension shall be granted in this regard, under any circumstances. This provision should be given wide publicity and also included conspicuously in the prospectus-cum-information brochure to be issued by the Board on board website.

III. The Board shall make a provision for the candidates to choose his/ her reservation category during registration in online counseling. The Government of Punjab may also set up a Committee to effect inter se gradation of candidates claiming reservation under certain categories, as indicated in the aforesaid memo dated 2nd July, 2013. In the absence of this Committee, the Board shall effect this inter se gradation, in accordance with the criteria laid down in the aforesaid memo dated 2nd July, 2013.

IV. A candidate shall be eligible to make claim for reservation under one reserved category only. However, the procedure for counselling/allotment of courses and/ or institutes shall be such that if a candidate is getting a course/ institution higher in his/ her order of preference, as a general candidate, he/she shall be so regarded, notwithstanding his/her claim as a reserved category

candidate. The seat under the reserved category shall then be offered to the candidates in that very reserved category.

V. The unfilled seat in any reserved category shall be merged in the General Category after all eligible candidates of the reserved categories have been given reasonable opportunity of making a choice.

D. ADMISSION SCHEDULE

I. The last date, up to which students can be admitted against vacancies will be as per academic calendar issued by AICTE in July 2021 for the academic session 2021-22 and strictly as per the orders of Honorable Supreme Court.

E. OVER-RIDING PROVISION:

I. Nothing in this notification shall be operative in so far as it is inconsistent with the law of the land as laid down of the judgment of the Honorable Supreme Court of India in the case of T.M.A. Pai Foundation and other vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) (8 SCC 481: AIR 2004 SC 355) or any other order of any Honorable Court. Any such inconsistency may be brought to the notice of the Government of Punjab, clearly highlighting the inconsistency, for immediate rectification.

II. The institutions which do not make admission on the basis of the Admission procedure as notified by the Board, from time to time or violate any of the above terms and conditions, shall automatically stand disaffiliated from the Board without any further notice.

III. The notifications/ circulars/ instructions of Government of Punjab referred to in A-V,VI,XI,XII,XIII,XIV,C-I,D-I,E-I and F-I of this notification shall be treated as part of this notification for all purposes and all the provisions of this notification shall be read along with the contents of said notification/ circulars and instructions.
