Subject:- Agreement / MoU with banks for secure keep up of question papers of All India Trade Test under CTS/ATS - regarding.

Sir,

You are aware that Semester system and conventional system All India Trade Test under CTS was held successfully from 21.01.2016 to 22.02.2016 in your respective States/UTs. As per prevailing practice, the packets of theory question papers were forwarded to the banks/Treasury/Police Stations for safe custody as per names & addresses provided by each State Directorates/U.Ts in the indent Performa-Format 'A'.


It is observed that some of the Bank Managers and Incharges of Police Stations were not aware of their role and surprised after receiving the packets of question papers. It is also noticed that some incharges of Police Stations did not received the packets and returned to Trade Testing Cell, DGT, New Delhi due to ignorance in this regard. TT Cell, DGT again forwarded the packets to the destination after correcting their addresses, but due to shortage of time lots of packets could not be forwarded and still lying in TT Cell. Keeping in view, the difficulties faced with Police Stations, it is suggested that agreement/MOU must be signed only with nearest banks instead of Police Stations/Treasury.

You may kindly fill the details of agreement/MOU with date in the Format 'A' while submission of indent for next AITT under CTS/ATS. Your indent will not be entertained if these details are not complete in indent.

In view of above, you are requested to kindly look into the matter and direct the concern official to make agreement with banks and also note that service charges of banks would be paid by the respective States/UTs so that the services of bank can be availed without any inconvenience.

Kindly acknowledge the receipt.
