Subject: Last chance of Trainees to appear in All India Trade Test (AITT) of Craftsmen (Conventional Pattern) under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS).

Sir,

As you are aware that Semester System under Craftsmen Training Scheme was introduced from the session started in August, 2013; the last batch for the Conventional Pattern of CTS was admitted in session January/ February, 2013.

As per the rule contained in Training Manual meant for CTS;

Five additional chances may be given to a failed trainee within a period of three years to pass the Final All India Trade Test for the award of National Trade Certificate.

Therefore, the last batches admitted in January/ February, 2013 for Conventional Pattern of CTS will complete the all five additional chances to appear in AITT of Craftsmen under CTS (Conventional Pattern) depending on the duration of training will be as under :-

Sl. No.	Duration of Training	Last chance to appear in AITT of Craftsmen (Conventional Pattern) under CTS	Remakes
1.	Six months	January, 2016	
2.	One year	July, 2016	
3.	Two years	July, 2017	
4.	Three years	July, 2018	

In view of above, it is clear that the trainees who had admitted in January/February, 2013 in the trades of six month duration have already availed their five chances and no question paper will be supplied for AITT to be held in July, 2016. Accordingly no question paper will be supplied for the trades of one year duration after July, 2016, for trades of two year duration July, 2017 and for the trades three year duration July, 2018.

You are therefore requested to inform all the failed trainees / ITIs and also raise indent of question papers for AITT of craftsman (conventional pattern) to be held in July 2016.
