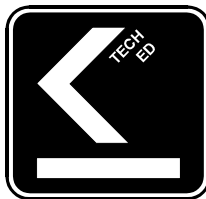

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRIVATE CANDIDATES AND FOR THE HEAD OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTE/CENTRES REGARDING FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM OF THE PRIVATE CANDIDATES UNDER CRAFTSMEN TRAINING SCHEME (SEMESTER SYSTEM PATTERN).

1. ELIGIBILITY

- i) The candidate who has passed SCVT exam in a specific trade can apply as a Private candidate in the same trade and he/she shall apply through a same Govt. ITI. For e.g. a student who has passed the SCVT Exam in the trade of Fitter is eligible to appear in Fitter trade as a Private Candidate. SCVT certificate holders who has received institutional training in same trade with same duration of training period and entry qualification.
- ii) Apprentices under the apprentices Act, 1961 who have failed six times in the All India Trade Tests for apprenticeship can appear as private candidates in the corresponding ITI trade only.. This will be only applicable to such apprentices who have not qualified earlier for the award of National Trade certificate by the NCVT.
- iii) SCVT trainees if desire to acquire National Trade Certificate as private candidates under NCVT then trainees after passing a particular semester exam in SCVT shall be allowed to appear in corresponding semester exam of AITT as private candidates under NCVT with the permission of board after passing a particular semester exam of SCVT.
- iv) Govt. Industrial Training Institutes will verify the authenticity of the particular of the private candidates keeping in view the guidelines given by DGT, New Delhi before permitting them to appear in the AITT. State must have affiliated trade units in trades opted by candidates and candidates must be attached to an ITI having affiliated trade units in trades opted by candidates.
- v) Numbers of candidates do not depends upon affiliated trades units of ITIs'.
- vi) There is no upper age limit.

2. GENERAL INFORMATION

- i) The application form complete in all respect should be submitted in duplicate alongwith proof of educational qualifications, Fee of Rs. 300/- (Cost of Form Rs. 100/- + Processing Fee Rs. 200/-) and annexure I to the head of the Institute/Centre concerned and the Institute/Centre will send the original copy of the application form and attested certificates (by principal of Govt. Industrial Training Institute) of qualification and State Trade certificate to the Board for scrutiny of the application.
- ii) All candidates whose name appear in the list of successful candidates (to be uploaded on website of the Board) after final scrutiny will have to deposit registration form fee Rs. 50/-, Registration fee Rs. 100/-, examination fee Rs. 500/-, DGT New Delhi Fee Rs. 75/- and Practical fee Rs. 50/- in the form of draft payable to the Secretary, Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Chandigarh.
- iii) The candidate should seek information with regard to date-sheet, Centre and Roll No. from the concerned Institution/Centre. **In the event of any candidate approaching the Board directly/indirectly, his application is liable to be cancelled/rejected.**
- iv) The Secretary of Punjab State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Chandigarh is not bound to intimate the reasons of rejection of eligibility. All information regarding eligible candidate will be sent to the concerned institute/centre before the start of examinations.
- v) These application forms should be routed through the Principal of a Govt. ITI.
- vi) For information on detailed syllabus, Head of the Institute/centre may be contacted.
- vii) Every page of Application form must be verified by the Principal of the ITI.
- viii) Last date of submission of application form by the candidate to the concerned Institute/Centre is **29-9-2017**.
- ix) Last date of submission of applications by the concerned Institute to Board is **16-10-2017**.
