
With reference to this office letter of even no. dated 06.12.2018 regarding issue of Hall Tickets for AITT under CTS (Semester System) to be held in January/February, 2019. In this regard, it is to inform that the activities scheduled for completing the hall ticket eligibility criteria, generation and download of Hall tickets has been revised as per the attached schedule. Now, the Group 4 & Group 5 of States/UTs has been merged and Group 6 & Group 7 is shifted accordingly. The last date of hall tickets download by ITI has been now scheduled till 15.01.2019.

In view of above, you are requested to communicate the revised schedule and direct all the concern to follow the new dates and also ensure entry of sessional marks, examination fees and attendance by the concerned ITIs under your control within scheduled date, so that hall tickets can be distributed to trainees well in advance before commencement of AITT under CTS from 21.01.2019.

NOTE:-Trainees without NCVT MIS generated Hall Ticket will not be allowed to appear in exam. Principal of concern ITIs should ensure that hall ticket is given only to the eligible trainees.
