

Extract of copy of letter No. 1/3/95-3PP-II/9619 dated 06.06.96 as amended vide Punjab Government Deptt. of Personnel and Administrative Reforms Letter No. 1/2/95-3PP-II/80 dated 01.01.99 from the Deputy Secretary, Personnel Government of Punjab, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Personnel Policies II Branch) to all Heads of Departments, etc., in then the State.

Subject : Bonafide resident of Punjab - Guidelines for the grant of residence certificate.

The matter regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of domicile for the purposes of admission to educational institutions(including technical/medical institutions). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr.Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-1421) wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence'be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:-
